

Renew Our Hearts: DCLC Retreat @ Home Pastor Andrea Cain

This year we will treat the 40 days of Lent as a spiritual retreat that offers us the opportunity to renew our hearts with a focus on God, worship, and prayer. The early church began in the homes of the early followers of Jesus. This is a new opportunity for us to do the same in 2021!

The church season of Lent begins Ash Wednesday and concludes 40 days later (not counting Sundays) on Easter. We journey from the reminder of our human morality to the joyous celebration of Jesus' resurrection. Lent is a holy 40 days of spiritual preparation and return to the Lord.


New Playlists coming February 1

Like many things this year, our Souper Bowl collection looks a little different. There won't be the traditional big soup can in the narthex, but we will still be observing our annual contribution. We will be collecting donations through our Special Hunger Jar online (during the week of Super Bowl you can select the team you are supporting), or by sending in a donation with your offering to the church office. Please make sure to specify that it is for the Special Hunger Jar. This year we are supporting the mission of supplying food to Grace Lutheran Church for their homeless program.

Can YOU help I-HELP?

I-HELP is a church wide project hosting those who are homeless and working toward improving their lives. Just one night a month we provide a hot meal and lunches for 15-25 guests. The hosts for each monthly visit have included various church groups including ChristCare, Ringing Praise Choir, Outreach Committees, Church Council, and even families just getting together to help those in need. By the end of 2020 the Desert Cross community will have served approximately 300 guests through the I-HELP program!

Since COVID, our hosts have been making the meals at home and meeting up at the Tempe Church parking lot where the foods are handed off to us (Glenn and/or Claudia). We then deliver the meals to the I-HELP guests at the facility where they are staying because we are not currently hosting the I-HELP guests at our location.
